Master technique - Drawing

Link artist/inspiration: World War 1 (Propaganda Posters)

#### Skills:

- To be able to choose a style of drawing suitable for the work (e.g. realistic or impressionistic).

- -Explore and record their plans (in their sketchbooks), ideas and evaluations to develop their ideas towards an outcome.
- -Draw in a more sustained way, revisiting a drawing over time.

## Master technique - Sculpture

## Link artist/inspiration - Durham city stained glass

#### Skills:

- Investigate how scale, display location and interactive elements impact 3D art.
- Persevere when constructions are challenging and work to problem solve more independently.
- Show life like qualities and real life proportions, or if more abstract, provoke different interpretations.
- Use tools to carve and add shapes, texture and pattern
- Combine visual and tactile qualities.
- Use frameworks (such as wire or moulds) to provide stability and forms.
