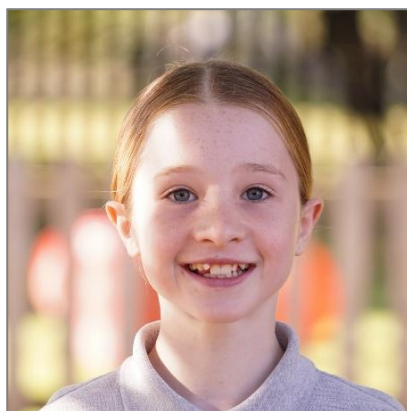

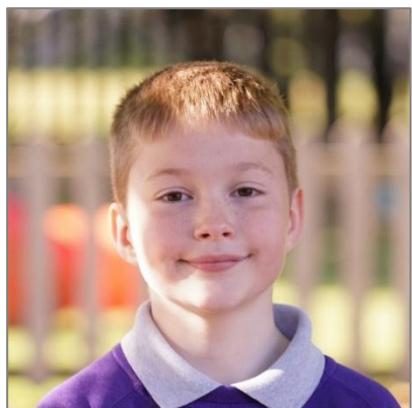

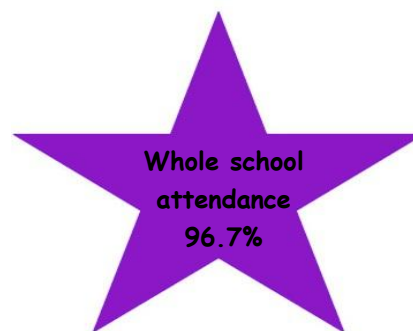
Leave of absence
