

How to trap an Ogre?

Equipment

- A pile of meat

- String

Instructions

1. Firstly, find an ogre trail: a path of ripped up bushes, shrubs and trees that an ogre leaves in its wake.
2. Next, leave a pile of food that ogres like to eat, such as raw meat, on the ogre trail preferably next to somewhere comfortable to rest, for instance a soft meadow to sit in or a wide-trunked tree to lean against. Ogres like it if the tree's branches provide shade to rest under, so look for a tree with lots of leaves.
3. Hide nearby quietly and wait.
4. Once the ogre has eaten the food, sat down and fallen into a deep sleep, bring the caged trailer to the slumbering ogre.
5. Once the ogre has eaten the food, sat down and fallen into a deep sleep, bring the caged trailer next to the slumbering ogre.
6. Wait for the ogre to wake up naturally. This may take a few hours. You may want to read a book while you wait.
7. Tie some pretty trinkets, such as shiny necklaces with sparkly pendants, to the end of a long stick with a piece of string.
8. As soon as the ogre is awake, lure it onto the cart by dangling the trinkets in front of its face. Play some soft music at the same time, for example, a child's lullaby, to keep it calm.
9. Afterwards, lock the cage tightly.
10. Finally, drive the ogre far away from your village.

Top Tips!

- Ogre catchers' shoes should have soft soles so that they can move quietly.
- Ogres hate bright lights being shined into their eyes.
- Ogres fall asleep immediately after eating and are then very difficult to wake.
