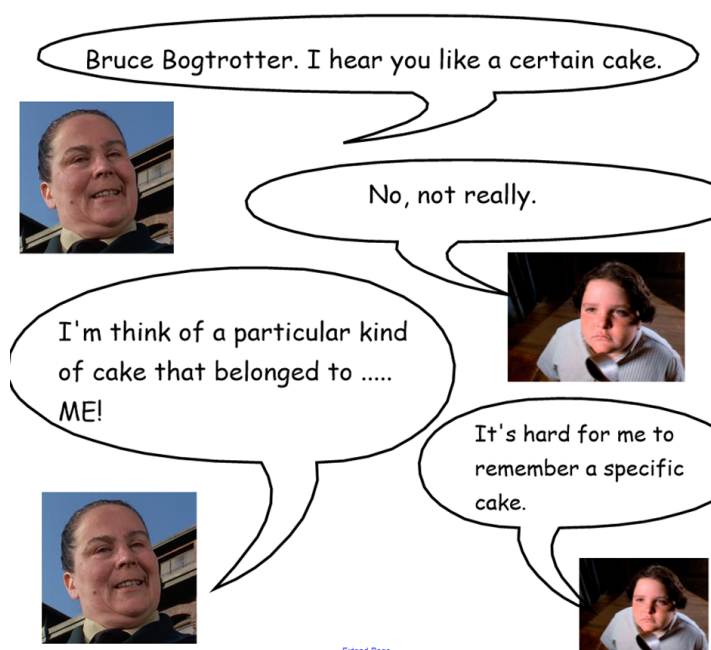
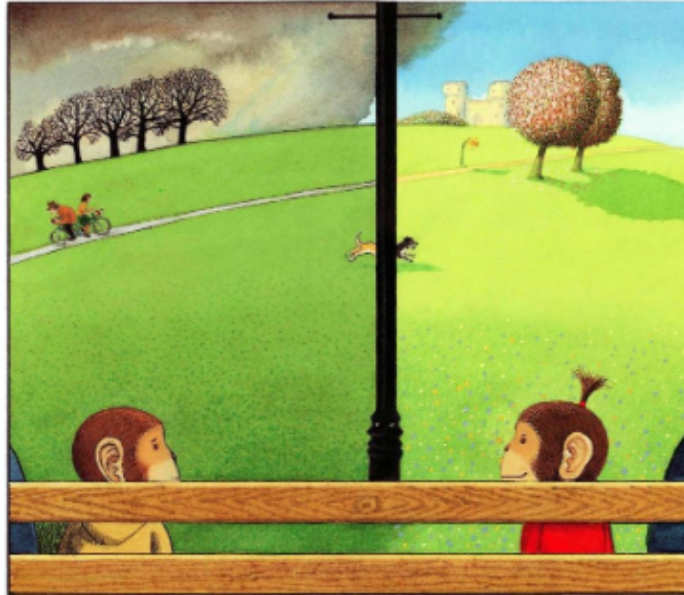


Last lesson we learnt how to write and punctuate direct speech.

Plonked herself down on the bench. Smiled.

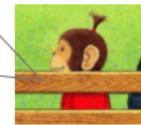


stammered

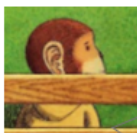
Slowly turned his head with a blanc expression.
