There has been an Olympic mascot for the Olympics, Paralympics and Winter Olympics ever since.

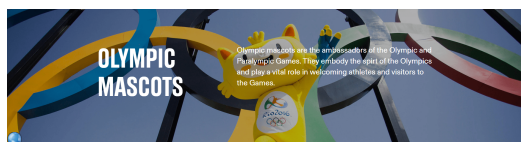

London black cab light

Shape of forehead is identical to Olympic stadium roof.

Eye is the lens of a camera, filming everything he sees.

Five bracelets in the colours of the Olympic rings.

- Named after the town of Munch Wenlock in Shropshire.
- Hosts traditional Munch Wenlock Games.
- Pierre De Coubertin's source of inspiration for modern Olympics.

Metallic look is explained as Wenlock being made from last drop of steel used to build Olympic stadium in London.
