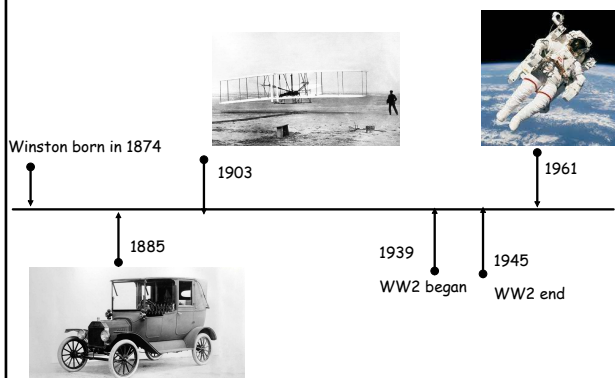
Winston Churchill is known all over the world for being a great public speaker and wartime leader.
