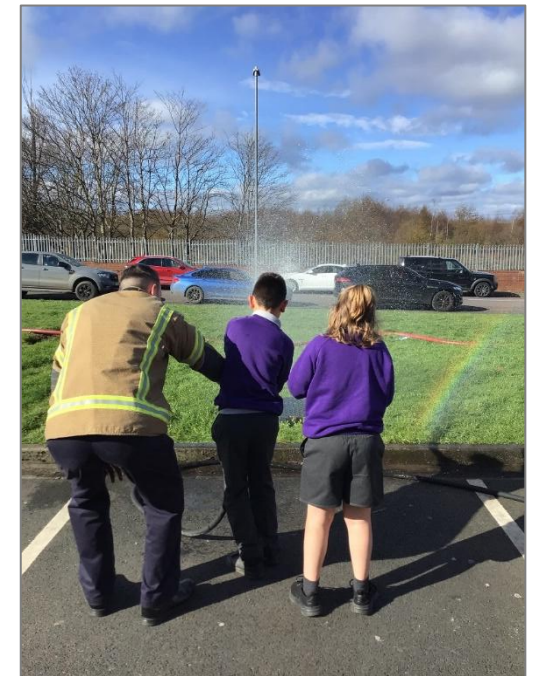


Meet our new Emmaville 'Mini Health Champs!'

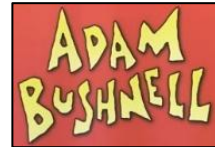

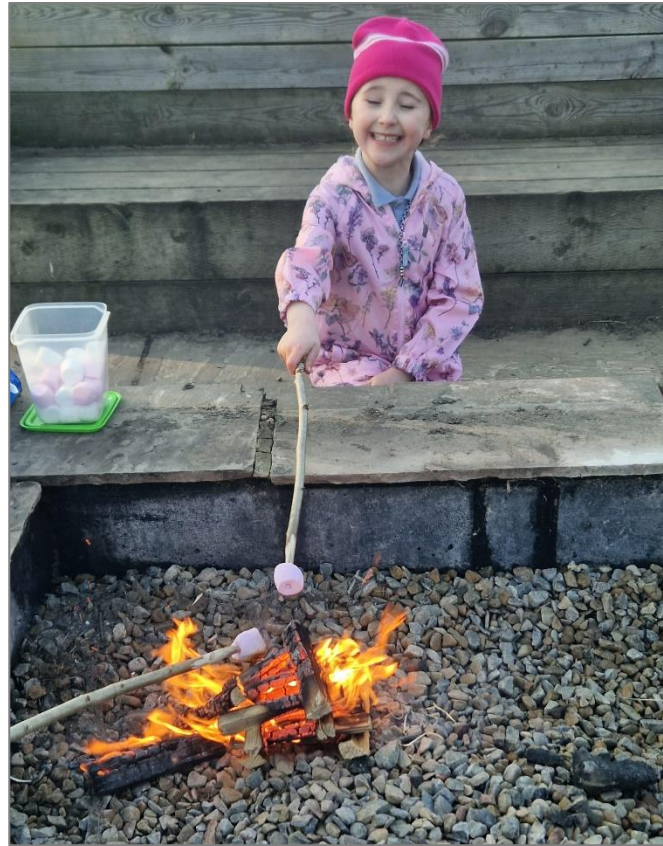
