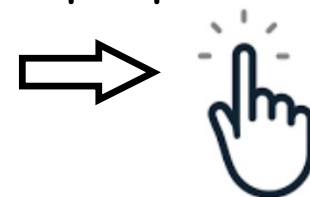


L.O. Combine images and ideas to create a local Christmas card

What do we associate with Gateshead and the North East?

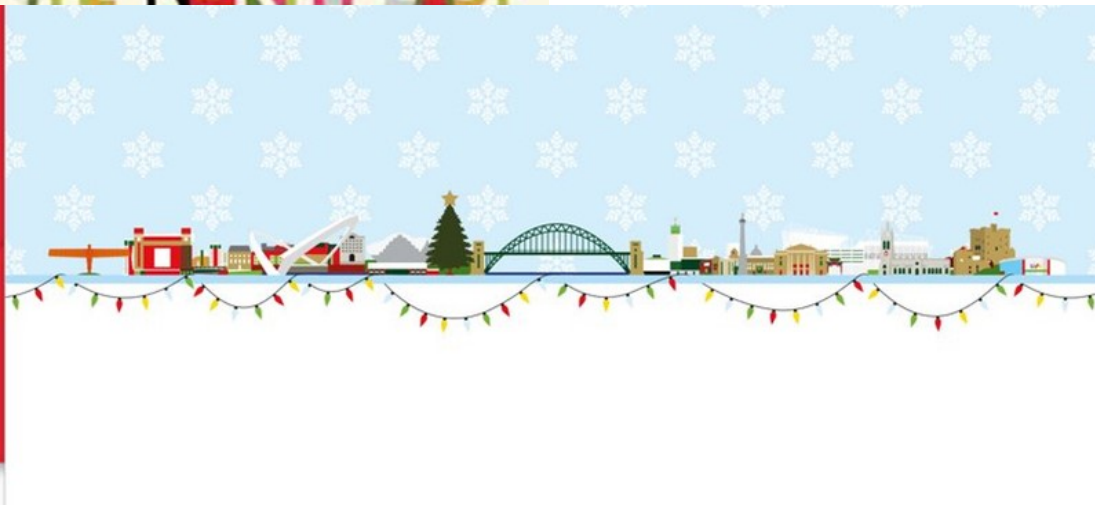
What images/sights do most people think of when they think of this area?
