Why do you think the animal is sitting on top of the lamp? What is the child trying to do?

There is distance between both of them - why and how can they close that gap?



Write a short descriptive piece, saying what you think is happening in this picture of kindness.

What is the creature feeling, and what words of encouragement might the little girl be saying to it?
