Opening - Ritchie has been left at the museum and is walking around.

Build up - Hears the clock strike midnight. Hears another noise.

Dilemma/Problem - The T-Rex has come to life.

It starts chasing him.

Resolution/Solution - Martin Luther King comes to life.

Advise Ritchie about the art of discussion and peaceful protest.
Ritchie and Martin negotiate with the T-Rex (which is only angry because it has a painful tooth) through discussion and non-violent protests.

Ending - The sun rises and both the T-Rex and MLK go back to their positions.

LO: To write an adventure story
