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Payment

Lessons involving 1-6 pupils:

Payment for a whole half term will be made by parents directly to the music teacher by the second last week of the previous half term.

Lessons involving more than 6 pupils:

Payment for a whole term (from January 2022) will be made by parents directly to the music teacher by the second last week of the previous term.

Please note: No refunds will be made for any children who wish to 'drop out' of a session during a term or half term. We expect parents to explain to their children that they have made a commitment to other children, parents and teachers to stick with the lessons for the full term or half term, depending on the size of the group. We expect all those who have booked to attend all of the sessions and complete the course. Learning how to play a musical instrument doesn't just happen'. To make progress, children need to put in time and effort. One of the benefits of learning a musical instrument is that children can see and hear the results of their efforts.

Please let the music teacher know as soon as possible if your child does not wish to continue with lessons into the next term or half term. This allows teachers time to contact and receive payment from anyone on the waiting list who may wish to take the place. Alternatively, those sharing the session may choose to pay more and benefit from a smaller group size.

Communication and Organisation

Please note, our school office will not be involved in the organisation of these sessions and staff will not be available to collect, supervise or drop off children to sessions.

Music teachers will collect and drop off to the following place by prior arrangement:

- Breakfast and After School Club Rooms
- The Main School Reception door if the lesson takes place in the Staff Room.
- An outside Classroom door near the Dance Studio if the lesson takes place in the Dance Studio.

The lessons will start promptly.

If for any reason your child is unable to attend their lesson, including illness, school outings and school training days, please let the music teacher know by leaving a telephone message directly with them. Our school office will not be passing on messages.

Children are able to go home at the end of the school day and return to school for their lesson. If they need to attend Breakfast or After School Club this will be charged at the normal rate. Before and After School Music lessons will not include food and drink, only music tuition.

Musical Instruments

School will be purchasing some stringed instruments which we can rent out to parents who do not wish to buy their own for their child at this stage.

Piano Lessons: Children will use the electric piano in school.

Rock and Pop Drums: Children will use a drum kit and/or drum pads in school. Ear defenders, for use in school, will be made available and cleaned between use. It is worth your child having their own set of drum sticks so that they can practice at home.
