We have attached this term's topic webs and creative homework to the bulletin, summer diary dates will follow shortly.

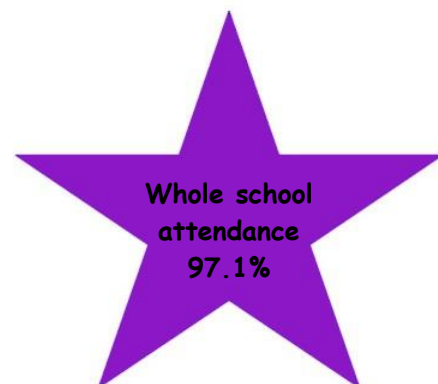
Any child, who is late for school, must be accompanied by their parent/carer in to school and signed in the late book with a reason for their lateness.
