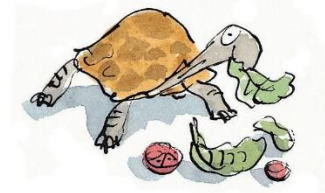


Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March - Follow on task from our live lesson:
