

**hunger** (noun) -

a feeling of discomfort or weakness caused by lack of food, coupled with the desire to eat.

"she was faint with hunger"

# imprison (verb) -

put or keep in prison or a place like a prison.

"he was imprisoned three times for his activities"



**ancient** (adjective) -

belonging to the very distant past and no longer in existence.

"the ancient civilizations of the Mediterranean"

**intriguing - adjective**

arousing one's curiosity or interest;  
fascinating.

"an intriguing story"
