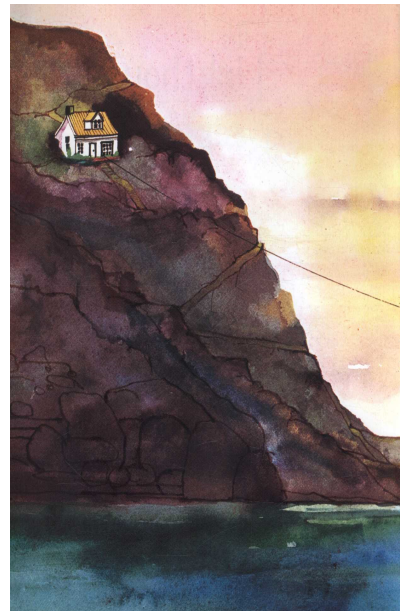
Can you remember what a "paired adjective" is?

Journey tales have some description of characters, places and things.

When two adjectives are used together to describe a noun, they are sometimes called "paired adjectives".

E.g. "cosy, white cottage"

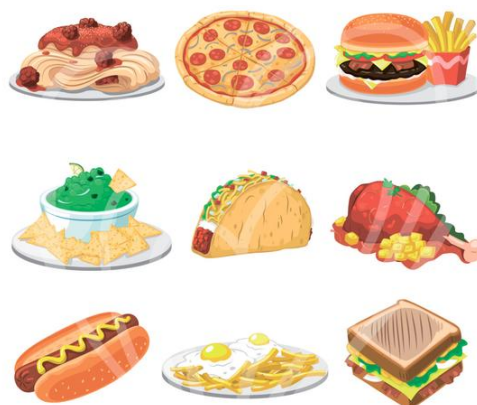

You need to come up with your own character for your own journey tale.

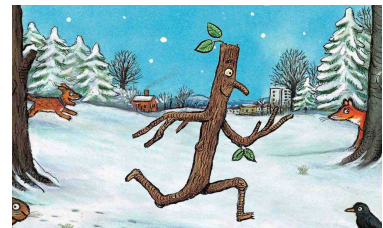
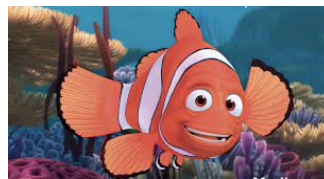
Start by drawing your character in your book.
