LO - I can use box-it-up method to plan my recount of lockdown.

Paragraphs	Key generic points	E.g. Best Holiday...Ever!	Innovation key points
Opening	Allows the reader to know what the recount is about. May include the 5 W's: who, what, where, why, when.	It was a holiday. Who: family, when - last week, what - went on a journey, where - Blackpool, why - to visit family and a new baby. Also talks about stopping and eating on the journey (short paragraphs)	
Paragraph 2	Details the first point that needs to be highlighted in the recount.	Arrive at the house. Share emotion. Meet new addition.	
Paragraph 3/4	Two more incidents/points that the author wants to share.	Short paragraphs. One about a restaurant visit. Detail about what was eaten.  Short paragraph about a day at the beach. Detail about some of the activities that they did at the beach. You could add more emotion.	
Paragraph 5	Longest paragraph that highlights the most important part of the recount.	The christening of baby Eva. Lots of detail in this as the author wants to share how special the day was. Lots of personal experiences and emotions/feelings.	
Ending	Reflecting on the experiences of the recount adventure. Highlight what was most enjoyable, memorable, what you have learnt.	A summary paragraph highlighting the important points of the holiday. Emotion - how the author felt about going home. Recapping on the highlights: weather, food, beach, family.
