Wednesday afternoon and all day Thursday and Friday

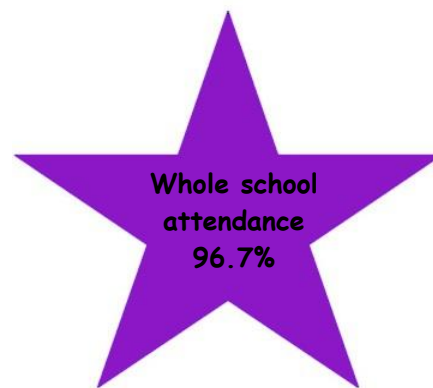
We also offer 30 hours a week places to those families that are eligible.
