Hair dryers contain a motor driven fan and a heating element.




Dec 6-08:45

When currents of electricity start flowing through the hair dryer, it first starts heating up the heating element, then starts making the electric motor spin.




When the electric motor spin stars to spin, this causes the fan to spin.




