


L.O. Develop a 2-D image into a 3-D sculpture



How many different modern Olympic events can you think of?

Can you work out what each of these pictograms stands for?



Choose a pictogram and re-create it on the square piece of card that you are given.

When you are happy with the outline shape, use black paint to fill in the pictogram.

Tip: always point your brush tip at the inside of the line you are painting up to - turn the drawing if you need to.





Once you have created your Olympic pictogram, grab a large sheet of aluminium foil and start scrunching and moulding it into a 3-D representation of your picture. Make sure that it is roughly the same size, so that the black image can act as the shadow of your foil sculpture.
