



## How to make Wormy Spaghetti

### What you need:

- long strands of spaghetti
- fresh tomato sauce
- herbs for garnishing
- the longest, juiciest worms you can find
- grated cheese

### What you do:

1. First, and most importantly, go out into the garden and look in the mud. Collect the longest, juiciest worms you can find and bring them back inside.
2. Secondly, boil some water and cook some regular spaghetti.
3. Then, chop your tomatoes finely and place these in a pan. Heat them up until they go soft and stir in some herbs to help disguise the taste.
4. Next, carefully mix your worms in with the spaghetti and place this on a plate. Cover this with a generous helping of tomato sauce and add some cheese to make sure you can't see the worms wriggling around!
5. Serve to your lucky dinner guest.
