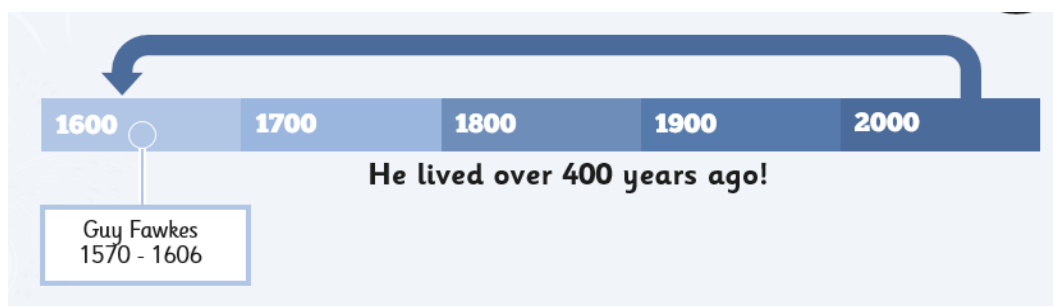


Does anyone know who this is?

Underneath the House of Parliament were many cellars. Guy Fawkes and his friends planned to put 36 barrels of gunpowder in one of these cellars, ready to blow up the King on November 5th.



Guy Fawkes was put in charge of guarding the gunpowder.

Luckily for the King, the plan was discovered and when the Houses of Parliament was searched by the King's guards, and Guy Fawkes was found with 36 barrels of gunpowder!



This is why we celebrate bonfire night today, remember the Gunpowder plot and how it failed. We burn bonfires with a "Guy" on top and set off fireworks.
