There will be no After School Club on Tuesday 22nd October due to staff training.

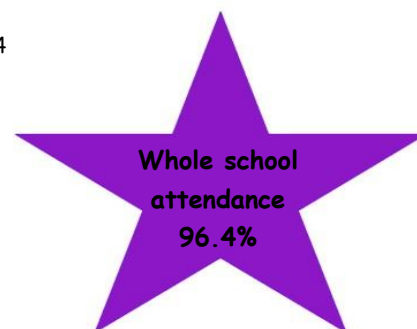
After School Club will resume on Wednesday 23rd October.
