I love it.



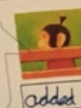
Sat her self down with a thump.

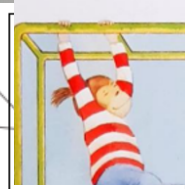

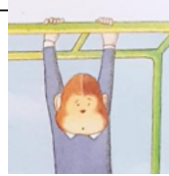
