

IF I HAD AN HOUR I WOULD ...

Title - Choose to talk about something that you LOVE to do.

Audience - Who will you be talking to and who will be judging?

Purpose - What is the aim of your speech: to persuade, inform or entertain?

Note down ideas. Could you add a personal story to make it more interesting?

Beginning - Capture the attention of the audience and tell them what you are going to be talking about and why.

Middle - You might want to include:

Why do you like it?

What makes it so enjoyable?

Do you need any special skills to do it? Do you have to practise lots?

How did you learn to do it?

Do you think other children (or adults) would like to do it too? Why?

Add your personality and make it unique, many others may be talking about the same topic.

End - Short statement relating back to the subject and purpose of the speech.

Try including a memorable line that the audience can take away with them.
