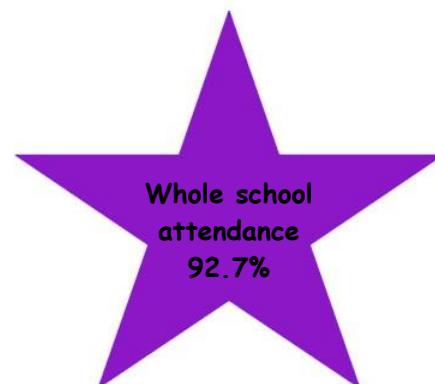

WEDNESDAY 3RD JULY (Years 1 - 6)

We are all getting excited for our Sports Day for 2019. Due to last year's success this event will once again be organised by the 'Gateshead School Sport Partnership'.

All children will participate in 8 activities, 4 of which are scored events where they can receive points for their house teams.

The scored events are the sprint, middle distance run, howler throw and standing long jump.

The remaining 4 events are our traditional sports day events - sack race, egg and spoon, skipping and parachute games.
