Dinner Money

School currently subsidises the cost of a school meal by 50p, resulting in an annual shortfall of up to £7,000. Due to budget constraints, we are having to consider ways to decrease this shortfall. After careful consideration, the Governing Body has taken the decision to raise the cost of a school meal to £2.90. The increase will be from Monday 5^{th} January. The increase will mean a reduction in the subsidy school is paying towards the cost of school meals to £1,000. We trust you will appreciate and support the reason behind the decision.


