

As stated in the news bulletin dated Thursday 29th March, the cost of a school meal will be increasing from Monday 3rd September to £2.50.

The school is charged £2.60 for every meal served to a child; we are therefore currently subsidising 30p for each meal. On average the school kitchen provides 196 meals per day. As school budgets are currently very tight, the Governing Body has realised that we cannot continue to subsidise school meals to this extent. Therefore after much discussion with schools in the cluster, and as a Governing Body we have taken the decision to raise the costs to £2.50 per day from the beginning of the autumn term 2018.
