The ancient Egyptians invented one of the earliest known writing systems.


The symbols they used were called hieroglyphs.

## How the pyramids were built remains a mystery to archaeologists.



The largest pyramid was built with 2.3 million blocks. It is believed that thousands of slaves cut up the blocks and then slowly moved them up the pyramid on ramps.

Scientists estimate that it would take at least 20,000 workers over 23 years to build the largest pyramid.
