#### 'Purple Poppies' 2-Year-Old Nursery places available

From September 2019 we will have a limited number of places available in our 2-year-old nursery provision. We offer up to 15 hours per week in three hour sessions. Either a morning place (9am - 12pm) or an afternoon place (12.30pm - 3.30pm).

Some children aged two are entitled to 15 hours of free early education and childcare. Your child might be eligible if you are claiming one of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Universal Credit please note that Universal Credit eligibility criteria for the two-year-old offer and EYPP are currently subject to consultation
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support Under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act
- Child Tax Credit
- You have a household income of less than £.16.190
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' (payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

Your child will be automatically eligible if they;

- Attract Disability Living allowance
- Have a current Statement of Special Educational Needs or an Education, Health and Care Plan
- Are looked after by their Local Authority
- Have left care through special guardianship or an adoption or residence order

If you are not eligible for a free place, we can also offer paid places which are currently charged at £5 per hour. Please call at the school office for an application form and return it by Friday  $15^{th}$  March.
