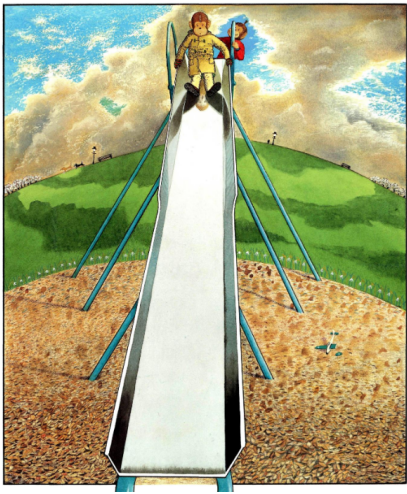


Lets warm up by playing a game of .....

Fluttering and dancing in the breeze.

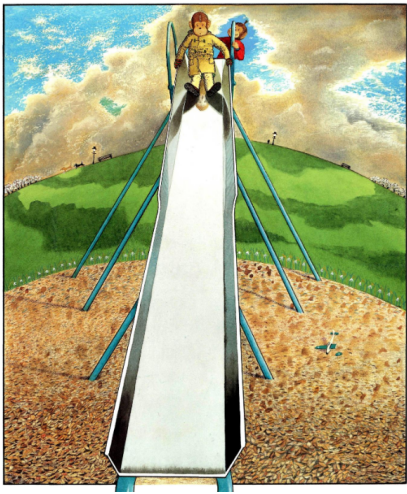
Continuous as the stars that shine
